Scullion medals in 3 State events; Relay team 5th

Senior Aiman Scullion won three medals at the State Division II Track Meet. He placed third in the 1,600-meter race at 4 minutes, 20.25 seconds. He placed eighth in the 3,200-meter at 9:45.50.

He was also a member for the 4 X 800-meter relay team that finished fifth in the Ohio High School Athletic Association Track and Field Championships held at Ohio State University on June 2 and 3.

Other members of the relay team were Seniors Mike Downs, Paul Shivers and Junior Patrick Gorby. The relay team's time was 8:07.06.

The four runners were on the Salem Cross Country Team that won the State Division II Cross Country Championship in November 2005. Scullion, Shivers and Gorby were on the 2004 State Champion Cross Country team as well, and their 4X800-relay team placed third at last year's state track meet.

In a school with a rich running history, Scullion accomplished several other firsts his senior year.

On March 18, he finished first in both the 800 (1:57.88) and 1,600 (4:18.75) races at the Indoor State Track

Championships at the University of Akron.

He qualified for the Penn Relays and the Midwest Meet of Champions. Scullion placed fourth in the full-metric-mile race at the Penn Relays, one of the oldest and largest track meets in the world, with a

time of 4:15.13. He finished 3rd in the 3,200 at the Midwest race in Jackson, Mich., with a time of 9:21.47.

He will attend Division I Kent State University on an athletic scholarship.
